## cidb Legislative Mandate

#### DEVELOPMENT

- Provide <u>strategic leadership</u> to construction industry stakeholders to stimulate sustainable growth, reform and improvement of the construction sector
- Promote <u>sustainable growth</u> of the construction industry and the participation of the emerging sector in the industry
- Determine, establish and promote <u>improved performance</u> and <u>best</u> practice of public and private sector clients, contractors and other participants in the construction delivery process

#### REGULATION

- Promote <u>uniform application of policy</u> throughout all spheres of government and promote <u>uniform and ethical standards</u>, construction procurement reform, and improved procurement and delivery management – including the Construction Code of Conduct
- Develop systematic methods for monitoring and regulating the performance of the industry and its stakeholders, including the <u>Registration of Projects and Contractors</u>

# cidb Register of Projects

- The Board must ... establish a register of projects to gather information on the nature, value and distribution of projects
  - for the public sector, on projects of which the value exceeds R200 000; or
  - for a public entity and private sector project, on projects of which the value exceeds R10 million
- ... and provide the basis for the best practice project assessment scheme to promote the performance of public and private sector clients in the development of the construction industry

## cidb Project Assessment Scheme (ii)

- Board has established the cidb Best Practice Project Assessment Scheme in terms of the following best practices with effect of 25 July 2019:
  - cidb Best Practice: Green Building Certification: published in Gazette 34158 of 1 April 2011;
  - cidb Standard for Developing Skills through Infrastructure Contracts: published in Gazette 36760 of 23 August 2013;
  - cidb Standard for Indirect Targeting for Enterprise Development through Construction Works Contracts: published in Gazette 36190 of 25 February 2013;
  - cidb Standard for Contract Participation Goals for Targeting Enterprises and Labour through Construction Works Contracts: published in Gazette 41237 of 10 November 2017;
  - cidb Standard for Minimum Requirements for Engaging Contractors and Sub-Contractors on Construction Works Contracts: published in Gazette 41237 of 10 November 2017.

- 23(2) After a date determined by the Minister ... all construction contracts above a prescribed tender value are subject to an assessment .... of compliance with best practice standards and guidelines published by the Board .....
- The amended Regulations were published on 18 September 2020

### cidb Best Practice: Construction Works Requirements for Digital 2D/3D Collaboration

### Objective

- The objective is to introduce minimum requirements for Building Information Modelling (BIM) digital 2D/3D collaboration as a best practice on public sector construction works contracts of a tender value equivalent to Grades 7 and above (currently above R20m)
- mandating Digital 2D/3D compliance on public sector contracts

### **Digital 2D/3D Requirements (i)**

- ISO 19650 Organization and digitization of information about buildings and civil engineering works, including building information modelling (BIM) - Information management using building information modelling, has been produced:
- Part 1: Concepts and principles
- Part 2: Delivery phase of the assets
- Part 3 Operational Phase of asset life cycle????





### Digital 2D/3D Requirements (iii)

- The Standard notes that several standards, methods and procedures are required for the successful implementation of the Standard, relating to a specific regions or countries that are not suitable for inclusion within an international standard
- ISO 19650 then notes that national standards bodies are encouraged to compile and document the standards, methods and procedures, relevant to the region or country they represent, within a national annex
- Should the annex include both SANS 19650 Part 2 and Part 3 or should separate annexes be developed?

### **Digital 2D/3D Requirements (i)**

- In terms of sections 5(2) of the Construction Industry Development Board Act, 2000 (Act no. 38 of 2000), the Construction Industry Development Board is empowered to promote best practice Standards
- The Board has identified Digital 2D/3D Collaboration as a best practice on construction works contracts with an expected tender value of Grade 7 and above, using non-proprietary, open-standard format for the exchange of information





### **Digital 2D/3D Requirements (ii)**

- Digital 2D/3D requires compliance to SANS 19650-2 Organization and digitization of information about buildings and civil engineering works, including building information modelling (BIM) - Information management using building information modelling - Part 2: Delivery phase of the assets
- Part 3 Operational Phase of asset life cycle????
